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The Michael Hansen Family came from the Grand Duchy of Luxemburg about one hundred years ago in order to escape from the wars and social unrest of Europe. They saw in the U.S.A. an opportunity to enjoy personal and religious freedom. One quality they all had in common--uprightness of character, respect for the rights of the neighbor, sense of duty, and firm adherence to the teachings and practice of the age-old Catholic Faith. Today the family's greatest boast is its large size--1064 known members. Consider the many sacrifices and good works performed for the Kingdom of God this represents; surely those privileged by God to hand on the precious gift of human life, can hope to receive that heavenly reward promised to those who feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, cloth the naked etc. In the family there are two Priests and fifteen Sisters called by God for the work of begetting and fostering spiritual life in God's children. By their consecrated lives of prayer and devotion to duty they call down God's blessings and special protection upon themselves and the families who fostered their vocations. 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Biographical Notes of Hansen Family

Michael Hansen Sr. born in Villa Masingen, Obersgegend, (present-day) Luxemburg, Aug.1, 1784, baptized same day, son of Michael Hansen & Margaret (nee) Zitten. Farmer by trade, but could not write. Drafted into infantry, 108th Regiment Deligne of the Army of the Rhine of Napoleon Bonaparte which saw action in Battles--Eylau (Jan.1807), Friedland (June, 1807), & Wagram (July,1809), in which battle 6000 French wounded. Served from 1804 to Jan.18,1810--date of pension certificate for wound received in leg. Married Maria Anna Molitor in 1810, came to U.S. about 1857 & stayed on son's farm, (Michael Jr.) near Rockville, Minn. Died Jan.23,1872. He & wife buried at Jacob's Prairie, Minn. Six sons & two daughters came to U.S. and established families. Spoke French, German & Luxemburg

Michael Hansen Jr. born in Obersgegend, Luxemburg, Dec.5,1811. Turner & farmer by trade. Served in Prussian Army as engineer (Apr.1, 1833--Sept.28, 1835. Came to U.S. in 1852, settled in Joliet, Ill, then made homestead near Rockville, Minn. Held nearly all town & school offices at various times; Postmaster of Rockville June 5,1865. Son, Hubert was 1st white child born in Rockville Township--June 16, 1858. Hubert obtained higher education at St. John's Univ.--1876-- & at St. Cloud, taught school in Dist.13,40 & 106. Graduated from Univ. of Iowa Law School. Opened law office in St. Cloud--1884. Held office of city justice, Judge of Probate. Flourishing insurance business.

Adam Hansen born in Obersgegend, Luxemburg, about 1812. Blacksmith by trade. Came to U.S. as widower in 1852 & settled in Cold Spring with his 3 children. Totally blind last 20 yrs. of his life. Amateur fiddler. Died 1896 at Cold Spring. Name of wife unknown.

Nicholas born about 1818, came to U.S with wife & settled in Ill. Owned hotel and stone quarry, died childless and rich.

Margaret Hansen born about 1821, married Matthias Dillenburg, came to U.S. about 1852. Kept hotel & saloon in Chicago. She died about 1907

Hubert Hansen born in Obersgegend, Luxemburg, May 12,1825. Came to U.S. 1852. Made homestead on shores of Grand Lake near Rockville, Minn. Married Catherine Maus in 1856 & bought 80-acre farm near Luxemburg, Minn. Three of children became Benedictine Sisters, one became a Benedictine Priest--Very Rev. Fr. Bonaventure OSB., Pro-vicar Apostolic of the Bahamas. Latter established many Missions in N. Dakota and the Bahamas, where he has been since 1921. When he was 8 yrs. old he was miraculously cured after his mother and sister made a pilgrimage to chapel of the Assumption at Cold Spring. Hubert Hansen died March 6, 1906.

Elizabeth Hansen married Henry Kalle & had 3 daughters: Mrs. John Neu, Mrs. Hubert Sauber, Mrs. Matthias Sauber. Some of the descendants of these families may be living in Chicago, but so far no positive trace of them has been found.

Michael Hansen (Rote--red) born in Obersgegend Aug.9, 1832; died at Cold Spring Dec.29, 1890. Came to U.S. 1852 with brother Hubert and made homestead with him on shores of Grand Lake, but in 1856 sold it and opened boarding house in Cold Spring, Minn. Married Mary Molitor, a niece of Maria Anna Molitor, had 1 daughter.

George Hansen born June 3, 1838 in Obersgegend, came to U.S. about 1857, married widow Flora Hein. Taught school at Mill River (Dist.40 about 1869) and at Half-way House (Dist.37) at which place he also kept tavern and saloon. Moved to St. Cloud where he opened saloon & was Justice of Peace till his death in 1914.
